Grading PLATO: **Students will not have a grade on their report card until they finish their course. Progress reports will be sent home with students to view their progress.**

Mastery Tests	40% this is set at 80%(can change at times)
Unit Tests	35%- Need to be completed at school
Semester Exam	20%- Need to be completed at school
Learning Goal Daily Writing	5% response to "Do Nows" and tracking progress in course

Class Expectations:

Be on time- 3rd tardy = referral to dean

Sit Quietly and Listen- when students enter class they need start their "Do Now" immediately

Attendance- in order for students to be successful in finishing their class and accomplishing their goals, attendance is a high priority. Skipping class will be a referral to the dean, and excessive unexcused absences will result in parent and dean contact.
