



We will expand our understanding of algebraic equations, functions, and graphic representations. We will also work with geometric formulas and calculating statistics.




Class Assignments and Homework

Class assignments and homework are displayed on the agenda board and updated on Schoology on a weekly basis. You are expected and given time to record them in your planners the first day of the week. Not having your planner is not an excuse for missing or incomplete assignments/homework. Every problem should be attempted on assignments and homework to receive credit; If any problems are blank it will be marked as incomplete. All assignments and homework must be completed in pencil. All graphs must be completed on graph paper.

Retesting Policy

If you score less than a 70% on a summative assessment, you are eligible to re-take the test. You are responsible for getting a Re-take Contract and Math Error Analysis Sheet (available in your math classroom), completing them thoroughly, and arranging a time to re-take the test with your math teacher.

Policies

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Late/make-up work policy

The expectation is that you submit all assignments on time. Late Assignments will have a 10% point deduction for each day they are late. If you do not turn an assignment in, a zero will be recorded in the gradebook.
