This Week's News

Reading News: This week we are working on nonfiction text features. This includes diagrams, captions, sidebars, photographs, etc. We are also working on verbs in grammar. We are adding 5 more vocabulary words: assemble, grumble, calculate, elegant, and privilege. These words go along with last week's words: fragile, defend, research, specific, and pledge. We are looking at definition, synonyms, and antonyms to better understand use of these words. Quiz on Friday for vocabulary

Math News: In math we are completing our unit on multiplication and division. We are still working on strategies to help us solve these problems. We are also going to focus on breaking apart word problems to figure out if they are multiplication or division word problems. The test is on Wednesday and a review sheet is coming home for homework, it looks exactly like the test.

Science and Social Studies News: In science we are going to be learning about plants. This includes the structures of a plant and why they are important. We will be testing on Science on Friday. A review will come home on Tuesday to help get ready for this test. In Social studies we are working on map skills and parts of a map.
