This Week's News

Reading News: This week we are working on how illustrations help us better understand a story. We are also working on adverbs in grammar. Adverbs are descriptive words that describe the verb in a sentence. We have 5 new vocabulary words that we are reviewing this week, we will add 5 more next week, and have the quiz on Friday the 28th. The first five words are: pause, gasp, ancient, observe, and brief.

Math News: In math we are working on understanding area of a shape. We can find the area by counting unit squares or by multiplying length by width. This unit goes quick because it is just an introduction, we will review this again later in the year adding in perimeter and rectilinear area. The plan is to test this math unit this Friday.

Science and Social Studies News: In science we are learning how to classify plants and animals. Plants we classify by plants with flowers, cones, and spores. Animals we will learn to classify first by vertebrates and invertebrates. Then we will go deeper and learn about amphibians, reptiles, birds, mammals, fish and invertebrates.
