Reading News: This week we are working on how illustrations help us better understand a story. We are also working on pronouns in grammar. Math News: In math, we are working on addition and subtraction within 1000. We are also going to work on rounding to the nearest 10 and 100. What I have noticed is that some students struggle with rounding and some struggle with subtracting across zeros.

Animals we will learn to classify first by vertebrates and invertebrates. Then we will go deeper and learn about amphibians, reptiles, birds, mammals, fish and invertebrates.
