Reading News: For the next couple weeks we are going to learn about the text structures often found in nonfiction texts. Sometimes it is set up to compare and contrast, show cause and effect, problem and solution, or the steps to do something. Our Vocabulary words for this Friday's quiz are: isolated, alter, gullible, emphasize, novice, clarify, spare, strain, remain, and exotic.

Math News: In math, we are moving onto equivalent fraction. This is an understanding of fractions that are equal because they are the same amount. We will learn how to figure this out using shapes and a number line. Some examples of equivalent fractions are: $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4} = \frac{3}{6}$ and $\frac{1}{3} = \frac{2}{6}$

Science and Social Studies News: We are working in science on our unit on the sun and the stars. In social studies we are learning about the west region of the united states. This test will be on Tuesday the 11th.
