## This Week's News

**Reading News:** This week we are going to start learning about elements of poetry and understanding the difference between figurative and literal language. We will learn about stanzas and lines. We will also understand how and what a simile, metaphor, hyperbole, onomatopoeia, alliteration, and personification are and how they are used in poetry. We are learning about the elements of dramas (plays, musicals, etc.) and how they elements compare to stories. For examples characters are called actors.

**Math News:** In math, we are working on telling time to the minute and elapsed time. If you leave your house at 7:45 and get to school 25 minutes later, what time did you get to school. Or, if a movie is 2 hours long and ends at 8:30, what time did the movie start.

**Science and Social Studies News:** In science we will be working on our matter unit.
