This Week We Are Learning

ELA: Main Idea and Supporting Details This week we will dive into main ideas and supporting details. We will learn how titles reflect main ideas and how to summarize informational texts. This unit will last for three weeks. Our third cold read will be on Friday, 9/28. Students have been working diligently on their first narrative writing piece and we will start publishing the end of the week.

Math Unit 2: This week will wrap up division strategies. Students will learn several ways to divide two and three digit numbers. This unit will also cover area and perimeter. Our test date will be September 25th.

Science: Matter: We will wrap up our matter unit this week by discussing magnets and magnetism. We are working towards a unit test by Friday. Study materials will be done together in class and will also come home with students throughout the week, so check accordion folders and dojo to know what kiddos should have 😊

Social Studies: Florida's Physical and Cultural Geography: We are wrapping up our social studies map unit this week. The final map unit test is an open book/open note test, so we have been working on it in class. Our second summative is a salt dough map which we will start on Monday, September 24. I will email directions home on how to make the salt dough.
