This Week We Are Learning

ELA: Stories, Plays and Poetry: This week we will complete a poetry study using “Love that Dog” as our anchor text. Students will learn about various forms of poetry and will study similes, metaphors, rhythm, rhyme and meter. Our first cold read of the second quarter will be done this week.

Math: Place Value: We will continue working with place value and number relationships. Extra practice can be done using IXL A.1-A.15. This is a short unit, and we will test on 10/29. A study guide will be sent home on Wednesday.

Science: Speed, Motion and Velocity: We are working hard studying the concepts of speed, motion and velocity and will be ready for our unit test on Friday, 10/26.

Social Studies: Florida’s first people: This week we will wrap up our study of Florida tribes, with students completing a compare and contrast graphic organizer of each of the 5 tribes in Florida.
