## This Week We Are Learning

### ELA: Greek Myths and Comparing Themes of Traditional literature

This week we will study several Greek myths and themes. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> cold read of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter will be on Tuesday- after this one there will only be 2 left of 4<sup>th</sup> grade!!!! Where has the year gone??? We will also take our last iReady Reading test on Thursday and Friday.

### Math: Parallel and Perpendicular Lines, symmetry and classifying quadrilaterals

We will wrap up this math unit on Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. A study guide was sent home on Friday, 4/5 and covers parallel and perpendicular lines, combining angles and classifying two-dimensional shapes. **IXL for additional practice: all of X, all of Y, W5 and Z5**

### Science: Weathering and Erosion
