Grading Criteria 2016 - 2017

Overall Grade

70% of the grade in the class is determined from the filming of events (5 events filmed 1st Semester & 5 2nd Semester) 30% will be gained from in class work (Daily Grade)

Class participation will be calculated by a daily participation grade. Each day will have a possible 5 point score.

Filming credits gained from 2^{nd} quarter WILL NOT be applied to 1^{st} quarter. Additional credits gained 1^{st} quarter will be able to be used 2^{nd} Quarter. Same for 3^{rd} and 4^{th} quarter. Filming credits will not be able to move from 1^{st} semester to 2^{nd} Semester

Each filming needs to be compared to a <u>Test</u> in other classes, and the In Class participation is comparable to <u>Homework</u> in other classes.

Daily Grades will be calculated as followed:

- 5 Worked all Period
- 4 Worked More than Half of Class
- 3 Worked Less than Half of Class
- 2 Did Homework
- 1 Did NOT Work or left class

Points may be lost for playing on the Internet or Phones. Sitting and watching others work (without being actively involved) does not constitute working. Taking up computer space, without working on the machine, will result in a loss of points. If a group has no new video to work on, a 3 is the best a person can get, if they do not make an attempt to help other groups out. If you have to be directed to do work, you can not receive a 5 for the class period.

Points may be withheld based upon the quality of filming (see Filming FAQ) or dedication and responsibility during class time (see In Class Expectations, daily grade).

For each Filming credit missed, it is possible to have a 2 Letter Grade Drop for the quarter (based upon the idea of perfect scores on in class participation).

Extra Credit is may be given each semester. It is given in cases where students have filmed additional to the class requirements (above the 5 required). A maximum of 5 points may be earned first semester and 10 points may be earned second semester, and the number of points given is subject to the event filmed and location of event.

- Extra credit for 1st semester must be completed prior to the start of cross over dates (November 29th)
- Additional extra credit is only allowed 2nd semester, due to the fact that there are less events possible to film during the term
