Sochi Olympic Camera Placements

During the XXII Olympic Winter Games in Sochi, NBC will be broadcasting a record number of hours, over 1300 hours. By watching the Olympics you have an opportunity to earn extra points to be used towards your daily grade. By completing this, you will earn 5 additional points on your daily total. Each item must be completed to earn the points. Up to 2 sheets may be done during the Olympics, but each must be for a different Venue, not different sports or events at the same location. The events may be watched during the NBC Broadcasts on Television or online at NBCOlympics.com. Complete the form from watching a complete event, not a highlight. The highlight may only show portions of the event. This must be turned in no later than February 24, 2014.

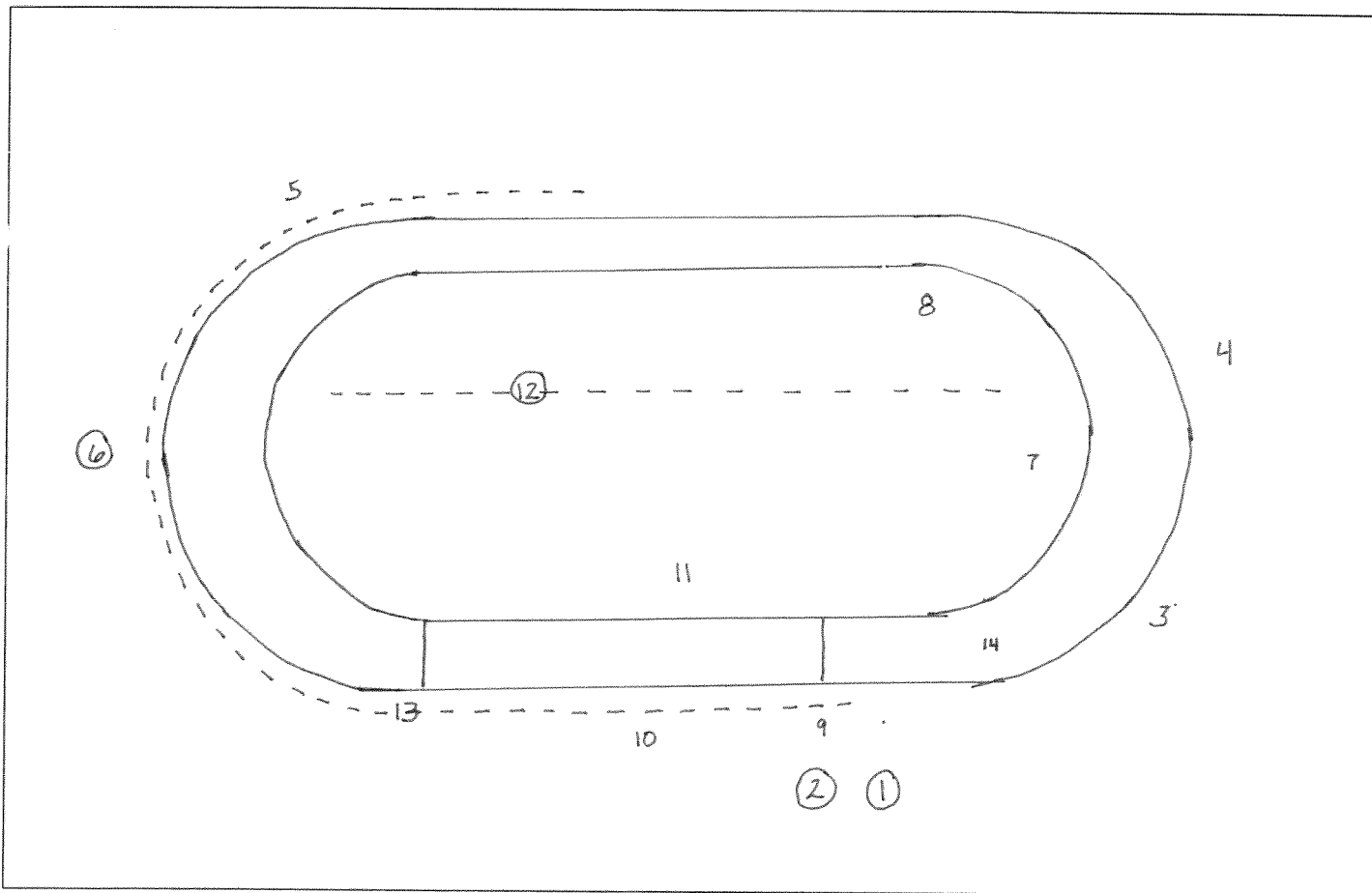
Name of Event: Long Track Speed Skating

Diagram of the Venue and Show the Camera Locations (Draw and Number it Clearly, use back to do a rough sketch)

Draw the layout of the venue and number the cameras that were used. If one camera was used more than others, make that camera 1. If cameras were used in a sequence, number them as they showed up on screen. If the camera was a robotic camera on a track or cable, draw a dashed line of the path. If 2 cameras are in approximately the same location, but one is elevated, circle the elevated camera, but number each differently. If cameras were clustered together, number them differently and explain the jobs in the next section



Any Special use of Cameras or Placements (Use back of page if more space is needed)

This would include any interesting placements, cameras clustered together, overhead shots, robotic cameras, manned-moving cameras or Special cameras only used for Slow motion, extreme close-ups or replays. Reference the camera number, from above, if so.
