

# Sports Media

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The course focuses on the practical application of filming and editing with regards to Athletic Video Journalism.

Students will be required to study the impact of media on society and to research the history of Sports Media. Entrants **MUST** be prepared to attend multiple after school activities, as this will count for part of the overall grade.

## Class Fee:

There will be a **\$20.00** fee for Television Production. This fee will cover the cost of the necessary media and maintenance cost for equipment.

## Syllabus:

The Sports Media curriculum has been designed capture video footage and to create the various highlight videos for each of the different sport programs at Nease High School.

Each student will have 3 different projects to contribute to, one for each season. For one Project each student will be a Primary or Secondary editor. The remaining 2 projects they will support an editor.

You will **NOT** be required to film the project you are working on, but you will have the opportunity to choose your required filmings.

## Filming Requirements:

Each student is required to film **10** events (complete games) during the 2016-2017 school year. Each quarter will have a set number of required filmings:

1<sup>st</sup> quarter ⇒ 2 Filmings

2<sup>nd</sup> quarter ⇒ 3 Filmings

3<sup>rd</sup> quarter ⇒ 2 Filmings

4<sup>th</sup> quarter ⇒ 3 Filmings

⇒ Home games count as 1 filming

⇒ Away games (excluding Bartram Trail, Creekside, Ponte Vedra and St Augustine) count as 2 filmings

➤ *Filming of Saturday events or during a student holiday will also count as 2*

⇒ Some events may count as 3 filmings, with Mr. Stephens approval

⇒ Each filming missed, during a semester, will result in a Full Letter Grade Drop

The student will have the opportunity to choose the events, dates, and locations for their filming on their own. I prefer not to assign specific dates to students to film, but if it becomes necessary to do so I will. It is very possible that the student will not be able to achieve these required numbers if they choose to only film events held on the Nease campus.

## Things to Remember:

⇒ No food, gum or drinks in class

⇒ Attendance and Tardy policy is as set in your student handbook

⇒ Any equipment lost or broken (due to neglect), is the responsibility of the student to reimburse the school

⇒ You are **NOT** allowed to charge your phones on the computers or in the room.
