eject(v)	to <b>throw</b> out
injection(n)	a shot; the " <b>throwing</b> " of medicine into the body by a needle
interjection(n)	a word <b>thrown</b> into a sentence or conversation
jettison(v)	to <b>throw</b> goods overboard to lighten the load on a boat or an airplane
projectile(n)	an object <b>thrown</b> into the air with great force
projector(n)	a machine that <b>throws</b> an image onto a wall
reject(v)	to <b>throw</b> something out because it's defective and can't be used again
subject(v)	to <b>throw</b> oneself under someone else's rule
trajectory(n)	the curved path of an object <b>thrown</b> into space
