preapprove (v)	to authorize or give permission <b>in advance</b>
precaution (n)	a measure taken <b>in advance</b> to prevent harm
precede (v)	to come <b>before</b> something else in time, order, or rank
predict (v)	to say what will happen <b>before</b> it occurs
prefix (n)	a syllable or word that comes <b>before</b> a root word to change its meaning
prejudge (v)	to make a decision <b>before</b> you have all of the facts
prepay (v)	to pay for something <b>before</b> it needs to be paid in full
pretest (n)	a test <b>before</b> the real test, usually given to see what is already known
prevent (v)	to stop something from happening <b>before</b> it occurs
preview (v)	to look at or see something <b>before</b> something or someone else
