Attached is a schedule to see the bands in attendance as well as some specific times for us.

For that day we need the following:

- *Arrive to Creekside 1pm (Band room open at 1230) to LOAD trailers, UHaul truck and buses. This is all members not just managers.*
- *2pm LOAD 5 buses and head to Bartram Trail HS*
- *240pm STANDS to support and watch bands until dinner break. (Bring \$\$\$ for concessions or your own meal)*
- *After Dinner break, back to stands for Orange Park and Beachside. After Beachside you will go to trailers and begin to dress and get instruments.*
- *AFTER your performance you will be in the endzone to watch and support Bartram Trail as final band. Then head to trailer and change/return instruments and load.*
- *930pm LOAD buses and return to Creekside.*
- *1015 PARENT PICK UP from Creekside*

****If you are taking your student from Bartram after event, we MUST have a note before Wednesday October 23rd stating you are taking your child (can not take other kids from event)**

****DRESS for the day when not in uniform is:**

RED BAND TSHIRT – BLACK SOCKS, BLACK SHOES (dinkles) and GYM SHORTS. Arrive to Creekside this way and change at event after Beachside HS performs.

****THIS IS THE biggest performance of the semester. Must be in attendance and must be prepared for success.**

****SUNSCREEN, Band Hats, Sunglasses are okay for this when NOT performing. This is often a warm and very sunny day. **DRINK TONS OF WATER the week leading up to this important performance assessment event****
