There are 17 bands!!! PARENTS it is a great afternoon of entertainment for only \$10.00!!! Come on out and spend the day watching BAND KIDS do their thing!!!! Tickets are purchased at the gate (cash/check). MS students are FREE if they wear the school Band Shirt. Gate monies raised help off set assessment fees for all MS and HS bands throughout the school year

**When you arrive you should have on: RED "Fall Guy" T shirt, Dinkles and Black Socks, Shorts and Hat. You will take your bibs with you to event and jackets will be on trailer.

**Bring \$\$ for concessions. You do not have to wait until dinner break to eat.
You can eat at anytime after we arrive - HOWEVER you must show
proper etiquette. Do not move during band performances, no
excessive loud noises, stay in groups of 4 or more and do not leave stadium area.

TRIP

We have 3 buses!! In *January* we will begin to sign up for Bus and Room assignments. Please continue to pay payments on time - this helps determine who can sign up provided you are on schedule with payments. T

AKE ADVANTAGE of the "Pick a Date" Fundraiser happening now. We have had 3 kids already pay for their trip using this method. 100% of money raised goes to your band trip!!!! We are currently working on the calendar to determine 2 days we will need to have rehearsal prior to the trip. We will do our best to keep them on a "normal marching day" of either Tuesday evening or Thursday after school in February and March prior to leaving. These will be mandatory for those going on the trip so we can prepare for the performance.

MARCHING

We have 3 more rehearsals. Do everything possible to be at every one of them as we make our final push to Assessment. Tuesday October 21st is our final STADIUM NIGHT where we will wear our Red Band Shirt. This rehearsal will run from 6-830pm. We do have a home game Thursday October 30th, but will NOT have rehearsal that week. Rehearsals for marching will be over the week of Marching MPA (October 23rd is final rehearsal)
