REHEARSALS

FAIR SHARE

The Creekside High School Band Boosters Association is a parent volunteer 501(c)(3) organization that supports the program here at Creekside throughout the year. One of the primary ways we financially support the band program is through collection of fair share dues that each student pays for the school year. These dues allow us to purchase music, new instruments and gear, complete instrument repairs, purchase and maintain marching uniforms, and much more.

Fair share for 2026-2027 is as follows:

- Instrumentalists (non-Percussion) - \$325
- Percussion - \$365
- Guard - \$450

Fair share can be paid all at once at the beginning of the school year or broken up into two payments with due dates of 8/11/26 and 1/17/27. Additional payment options are always available. There is a \$50 sibling discount for families with more than one student in the band program.

Please also note that Guard members do **NOT** need to attend Uniform Day.

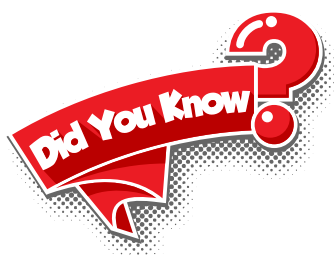
INSTRUMENTS

Did you know that you can subscribe to the calendar in the Band App? This will add all events directly into your phone's calendar. It's a great way for students and parents to keep up with practices, meetings, football games, and other events. If an addition or update is made within the band app calendar, it will automatically update in your phone's calendar as well.

- Under "My Bands," select the Power of Creekside
- Then select "Events" near the top of the page.
- To the right of the month/year, there is a calendar icon with a little gear, select this.
- Export band calendar to put into iOS or Android calendar. You are able to color code and name the calendar.

LEVEL II CLEARANCE

Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, individuals are required to have cleared fingerprints through the St. Johns County School District who are **assigned volunteer duties of driving or chaperoning students on an overnight field study or activity**, including athletics. The average cost for volunteer fingerprinting is \$83.25 and fingerprints are effective for 5 years.

This will be applicable to any volunteers who may be interested in the overnight/band trip. Trip details will be announced as soon as we have approvals completed in the next week or two. Details that were sent out via ParentSquare are listed below.

If an individual has not yet completed a volunteer application through the Raptor system, he/she will complete the form online. Upon submission the applicant will receive an email directing him/her to the website showing steps for Level II volunteer fingerprinting. Upon successful results, the applicant will be notified by Volunteer Services and be eligible to take part in activities requiring fingerprinting.

If an individual is already in the Raptor volunteer system, he/she is to go to the SJCSD Volunteer Services site for steps to have fingerprints completed. Upon successful results, the applicant will be notified by Volunteer Services and be eligible to take part in activities requiring fingerprinting.

Having completed fingerprints does not ensure an applicant's approval to take part in an event. This is up to the discretion of the activity sponsor and/or school Principal. For additional assistance or questions, please call Volunteer Services at 904-547-3945.

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
