## ORANGE FORM Test Piece: Polly Wolly Doodle


This form works on your technical ability to play a little faster! Play the following exercises slow at first and work to get the speed faster.

Remember to clap the rhythm first.

Check the key signature, too!

**KEY SIGNATURE**: We say that music is written "in the key of C," (or a different letter of the musical alphabet) which means that a specific musical pitch is the basis for the song or the "home note" for the song. The song usually begins with and/or ends with and gives the piece of music a sense of finality.

The key signature is found at the beginning of a piece of music between the Treble clef and the Time Signature.
