I am very excited that your child has shown an interest in becoming a member of the Singing Jaguars. Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade Chorus will be offered on Thursdays after school from 2:50 - 4:00 P.M. beginning on **September 15th** and ending in April. Participation in chorus requires attendance at all rehearsals and performances. Missing performances due to other activities will result in dismissal from chorus. Transportation home will have to be provided by the parents. If your son/daughter will be going home with someone other than yourself or walking home, I will need a letter stating your intentions. If an emergency arises that interferes with transportation for your child, please contact me at school and I will accommodate him/her. The first rehearsal is scheduled for Thursday, September 15th! © Please note 5th graders who are a Safety Patrol MAY participate in Chorus as well. The students would attend Chorus following their Safety Patrol duty.

### My Philosophy for Teaching Chorus

Singing is a universal language all its own and is a channel for all types of expression. For instance, when someone is happy, he/she may sing a fast, upbeat song. On the other hand, when someone is sad, he/she may sing a slow, subtle song. Singing is also educational. The lyrics to songs tell stories so people can learn a lot from studying the words.

Chorus is a great way for students to express themselves and be a part of a group at the same time. I feel that being a part of chorus will be a memorable experience and I look forward to sharing those experiences with your child.

#### Rules:

Students who are in chorus are expected to follow these rules:

1) Attend all rehearsals.

<u>Consequences:</u> Students who have more than 3 <u>unexcused</u> absences will be dismissed from chorus. I will notify the student's parent(s) after the second unexcused absence. Ex. Forgetting to attend.

2) Attend all performances.

<u>Consequence:</u> Students who miss one performance, and I have <u>not</u> received a note from a parent or guardian will be dismissed from chorus pending discussion with the student's parent(s).

\*\*\* Every voice is important at each performance, whether a child has a speaking or dance part. We work together as a team!

3) Wear the chorus uniform to all performances.

<u>Consequences:</u> <u>First Time:</u> Students who do not wear their chorus uniform will be asked to sit out of that performance, and their parent(s) will be notified.

<u>Second Time:</u> Students who do not wear their chorus uniform to more than one performance, will be dismissed from the chorus.

4) Speak and act in a respectful manner.

<u>Consequences:</u> <u>First Time:</u> Warning

<u>Second Time:</u> Time Out - Notify parent(s) by letter that will need to be returned to Mrs. Isabelle the next day.

Third Time: Dismissal from chorus.

5) Keep all gum for lunch and recess.

#### Uniform:

The students are required to wear their uniform to <u>all</u> performances. Students who are not dressed in the <u>complete</u> uniform, will not be allowed to perform. The uniform is as follows:

- Royal blue T-shirt with silkscreen print on front/back
   In addition to the children wearing this shirt to ALL the
   performances, the children may also wear it to school on "School
   Spirit Day Friday's."
- \*\*\* I will be ordering the shirt from O'Meara's Advertising Specialties, so you do NOT need to shop for one. My goal is to have all the students look the same and alleviate you from having to shop!
  - 2) Solid <u>tan</u> / <u>khaki</u> (only) slacks (girls and boys) Stores sell out of these fast, so I would try to buy these as soon as possible!
- \*\*\* Jeans are not permitted for any of the students.

- 4) Black shoes girls and boys
  \*\*\* Sneakers are not permitted for any of the students.
- 5) Black (only) ankle socks for the girls
- 6) Black (only) ankle or crew socks for the boys

#### Performances

The Singing Jaguars perform frequently. All the students will be required to make-up all schoolwork that is missed due to a performance.
