



Supreme Court

- Highest court in the federal system
- Nine Justices, meeting in Washington, D.C.
- Appeals jurisdiction through *certiorari* process
- Limited original jurisdiction over some cases



Courts of Appeal

- Intermediate level in the federal system
- 12 regional "circuit" courts, including D.C. Circuit
- No original jurisdiction; strictly appellate



District Courts

- Lowest level in the federal system
- 94 judicial districts in 50 states & territories
 - No appellate jurisdiction
- Original jurisdiction over most cases
