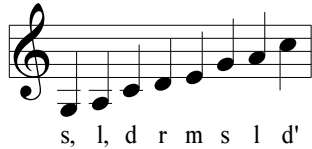

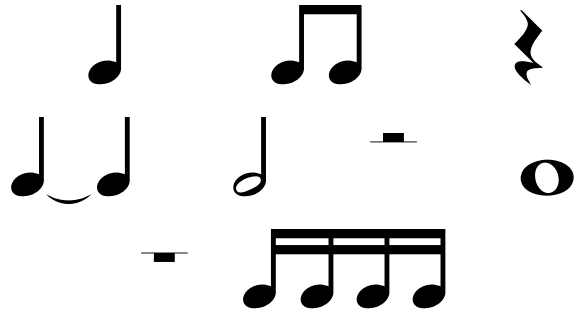

I can

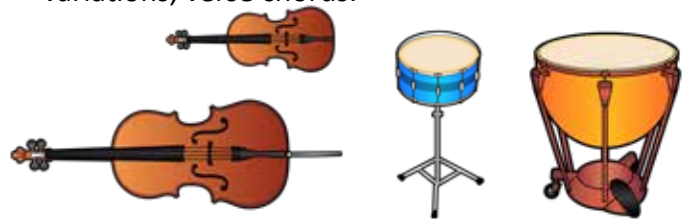
- identify and classify classroom instruments by sight and sound.
