- Students are not required to attend all sessions if participating in the District lab, but credit will not be given until the final exam is completed.
- Students who attend the District Lab are required to sign in daily.
- Since the lab is a testing and learning environment, no music, cell phones, tablets, etc. will be permitted for student use during lab time.
- No personal devices other than headphones or earbuds used to view summer school module videos only may be used in the lab.
- **Final exams must be proctored at the District Summer School Lab.** Students may come to the District lab on any day of summer school to have their final exam proctored. **Students must have completed ALL coursework prior to taking their final exam. Students or parents should notify the District lab facilitator at least 24 hours in advance of the day they are planning to have their final exam proctored to verify that the student has completed all coursework and is eligible to test.**
- **EOCs (end of course exams) must be completed at the student's zoned school. Courses with EOCs include Civics (middle school only), Geometry, Biology, and US History. Students should contact the school testing coordinator to make arrangements for testing.**
- If a student is asked to leave a session for inappropriate behavior or lack of progress, or leaves the lab premises without permission, the student will not be allowed to return to the lab except to take the proctored final exam.
- A final grade report will be accessible by the student's school at the conclusion of summer school.
