## St. Johns County School District Summer School Student Contract 2019

Welcome! By completing courses you need to do grade recovery for, you may promote to the next grade level or graduate.

Use of the Summer School Lab is a privilege and should be treated as such. You will be required to comply with the following guidelines to continue your time in the lab for summer school:

- Lab hours for the summer are <u>9:00 AM to Noon</u>, Monday through Friday.
- All end of semester tests will be locked and must be taken in the District lab. You must complete all coursework prior to
  taking your final exam. Check with the virtual lab facilitator in advance of taking your final exam. You may do quizzes and
  other coursework at home. EOCs must be completed at the student's zoned school and prior arrangements to test should
  be made with the school testing coordinator. Subjects with EOCs include Civics (middle school only), Geometry, Biology,
  and US History.
- Summer school courses do not meet requirements for NCAA or Bright Futures Scholarship or State University admissions eligibility.
- Trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship are essential to success in this lab.
- If you choose to work at home, your signature on this contract indicates that you are making a commitment that the assignments done were completed by you. Any assistance provided by others was for the purpose of helping you understand the content.
- Any student that uses another person's work or any other fraudulent or deceptive means to complete a test or assignment will be dismissed from the District lab until a parent conference can be arranged.
- The lab is a **QUIET ZONE**, a learning and testing environment so that all participants may fully concentrate on their work without distraction. The use of personal devices (cell phones, tablets, iPods, etc.) is **prohibited** in the Summer School Lab. You may bring earbuds or headphones as some modules have videos to watch. You may <u>not</u> stream music or any other content through the headphones other than the summer school videos.
- If you are asked to leave the lab due to repeated non-compliance with any rule, you will not be allowed to return to the lab except to complete the proctored final exam.
- Students who attend the District Lab are required to sign in daily.
- At all times, students must abide by the Student Code of Conduct.
- Students who are out of dress code will not be permitted to participate in the lab. Please refer to pages 13-14 of the Student Code of Conduct for specific information on dress code requirements.
