Directions to retrieve your scores

2. Select "Get PSAT /NMSQT Scores Now" You will be directed to set up an account with College Board. Select "Sign Up" on the next screen.
3. Fill in the blanks to create your student account.
 - Make sure to use your full name, not nicknames
 - Make sure the student email is one you use and check often
 - Graduation dates will be May of your graduation year
 - Make sure to keep your username and password in a safe place. You will come back to this site to check AP scores and PSAT/SAT scores.
 - Make sure to include a parent email in case you forget your password/username!
 - Select "CC Parent Email Service" so your parents are aware of announcements including test dates and score reporting dates
 - After you check your information, select next. You will be directed on how to retrieve your scores.
4. You can create a PDF of your unofficial score report.
 - Click on "View Details" located under your score.
 - On the next screen select "Download Report" (top right corner).
 - You can save the PDF to your computer and/or print.
 - This is great information to bring to guidance meetings or SAT preparation/tutoring.
5. On the College Board site you can also find study/practice materials, connections to Khan Academy preparation tools and documents on how to read your score report.
