



BINDER ORGANIZATION

Your binder should stay neat, clean, and should be brought to school and home **EVERY DAY.**

Stay Organized in 5th Grade!

This is your year to get ready for Middle School. Staying organized with your binder will help you have what you need for all classes. It will also help you keep track of homework, what to study, and will help you keep up with projects and due dates.

Always Keep In Your Binder:

1. **PLANNER** - Fill out every morning. Get signed every night (except Friday).
2. **Blue COMMUNICATION FOLDER**
3. **ZIPPERED PENCIL BAG** (or zippered compartments in the binder) should always contain 2 sharpened Pencils, Pencil Sharpener, colored pencils, red pens, scissors, glue stick and a Highlighter
4. Extra **NOTEBOOK PAPER**
5. **Plastic Tab Dividers with POCKETS** – Labeled with the following: Reading, Writing, Social Studies, Math and Science.
6. Keep **this paper** in your binder to help you organize.

- ***Math & Science** – All assignments will be written in the **PLANNER** daily.
